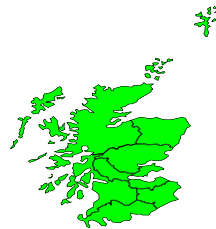


DIRECTIONS => Take State Road 520 (Exit 201) off of Interstate 95. Go 11.4 miles east through Cocoa over the Indian River and the Banana River to Hwy A1A. Turn right (south) for 1.7 miles. The LaQuinta Inn Cocoa Beach will be on the west side of the road. To drive to the Cocoa Beach Recreation Center from LaQuinta Inn go south on A1A for 1.7 miles. Go past where A1A splits. Go past Minutemen Causeway and turn right onto South 5th Street. Turn left onto Brevard Ave South. Turn right onto Ramp Road. You will see the Playhouse and the Rec Center on your right. Turn right onto Sunrise Drive. Park in the Rec Center parking lot, on the street, or in the elementary school parking lot on the west side of the street.

GUEST INSTRUCTOR Kay Munn of Kingston, Ontario, Canada. Kay grew up in Glasgow, where she was introduced to Scottish Country Dancing in school. In 1986, she crossed the Atlantic, and lived in the Toronto area, South Carolina and upstate New York. One year, in preparation for a Burns Night celebration, she told some friends that if they could find the music to Scotland the Brave, she would teach them a Scottish dance. The music was provided and they danced the 'Gay Gordons'. This led to her re-entry into the world of dance, and she enjoyed classes with renowned deviser, Terry Glasspool. Returning to Canada in 2001, Kay was immediately adopted by the local Royal Scottish Country Dance Society (RSCDS) Kingston, Ontario, Branch, and encouraged to pursue a Teaching Certificate. With Branch support and an RSCDS scholarship, she obtained her certificate in St Andrews. Kay has taught at Pinewoods Scottish sessions, and has been a frequent teacher at Mainewoods Dance Camp. In the summer of 2015 she joined the faculty of Stockton Folk Dance Camp in California. Locally, she teaches classes and workshops at all levels. The dance 'The Flower of Glasgow' was written for Kay and recently published by the RSCDS.
